If there is an interest in proceeding with the enrollment process, we will require completion of the Application for Admission form and submission of the relevant documentation, including the Identity Document or Birth Certificate, latest School Report, and Road to Health records.

All applicants will be required to undergo an entrance screening and a personal interview with the Principal or Deputy Head.

The acceptance of learners into Woodward Private School, Johannesburg, will be based on the following criteria:

- A comprehensive review of the learner's overall development, including their screening results and past reports.
- The Principal is satisfied with the report from the previous school. Note that parents should be aware that a reference may be sought from the student's former school/Principal.
- The learner is of the appropriate age for the applied grade.
- The learner is capable both academically and emotionally of entering at that level
- There is a place available in the grade for which application is made
- The non-refundable registration fee has been paid to the school in order to secure a place

DISCOUNTS:

The third child qualifies for a 10% discount on the basic fee on condition that all three learners are in attendance at the same time.

Fees that are paid annually in advance by 1 January, benefit from a 10% discount as per our Fee Structure.

BURSARIES

Parents of current learners who are experiencing temporary financial hardship may apply for short term financial assistance in the form of a bursary. Once allocated, a bursary holder's financial circumstances are reviewed on a QUARTERLY basis. Applicants are required to complete the detailed application form, which is available at the Accounts office. All applications are subject to comprehensive forensic financial scrutiny. New learners applying to enter the Grade 10, 11 and 12 are required to write an entrance baseline assessment, which will assess the learner's ability in English and Mathematics [Mathematical Literacy]. Scholarships may be awarded to students on merit.
